

(Hebrews 12:5-8) "And you have forgotten the exhortation which speaks to you as to sons: "My son, do not despise the chastening of the LORD, Nor be discouraged when you are rebuked by Him; {6} For whom the LORD loves He chastens, And scourges every son whom He receives." {7} If you endure chastening, God deals with you as with sons; for what son is there whom a father does not chasten? {8} But if you are without chastening, of which all have become partakers, then you are illegitimate and not sons."

(Romans 2:21-24) "You, therefore, who teach another, do you not teach yourself? You who preach that a man should not steal, do you steal? {22} You who say, "Do not commit adultery," do you commit adultery? ... {23} You who make your boast in the law, do you dishonor God through breaking the law? {24} For "the name of God is blasphemed among the Gentiles because of you," as it is written."

(Deuteronomy 17:18-20) ""Also it shall be, when he sits on the throne of his kingdom, that he shall write for himself a copy of

this law in a book... {19} "And it shall be with him, and he shall read it all the days of his life, that he may learn to fear the LORD his God and be careful to observe all the words of this law and these statutes, {20} "that his heart may not be lifted above his brethren, that he may not turn aside from the commandment to the right hand or to the left, and that he may prolong his days in his kingdom, he and his children in the midst of Israel."

(Deuteronomy 7:3) ""Nor shall you make marriages with them. You shall not give your daughter to their son, nor take their daughter for your son."
