The Bible describes two aspects of God's holiness that will build up the picture of His beauty:

1. His _____, Isaiah 6:1, 3, 2:2

(Exodus 3:5) "Then He said, "Do not draw near this place. Take your sandals off your feet, for the place where you stand is holy ground.""

(Exodus 12:16) "On the first day there shall be a holy convocation, and on the seventh day there shall be a holy convocation"

(Exodus 15:11) "Who is like You, O LORD, among the gods? Who is like You, glorious in holiness, Fearful in praises, doing wonders?"

(Isaiah 40:25-26) ""To whom then will you liken Me, Or to whom shall I be equal?" says the Holy One. {26} Lift up your eyes on high, And see who has created these things, ..."

(Isaiah 57:15) "For thus says the High and Lofty One Who inhabits eternity, whose name is Holy: "I dwell in the high and holy place,

With him who has a contrite and humble spirit, To revive the spirit of the humble, And to revive the heart of the contrite ones."
