

Everlasting life is a gift from God that no one can ever take away from you.




If you want Jesus to be your Savior, believe in Him now. You can tell Him in prayer about your decision.



After you have believed in Jesus, here are four things to help you grow as God's child.

- 1. Read and obey your Bible.** Read some verses from the Bible every day. "Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee" (Psalm 119:11).
- 2. Pray.** Talk to God every day. When you sin, confess your sin to Him, and He will forgive you. "Evening, and morning, and noon, will I pray" (Psalm 55:17).




**3. Attend Sunday School and church.** Go every Sunday to learn more about Jesus. "I was glad when they said unto me, Let us go into the house of the LORD" (Psalm 122:1).

**4. Be baptized.** Talk to your pastor about being baptized. A person should be baptized after he believes in Jesus to show others that he has trusted Jesus as his Savior. "They that gladly received his word were baptized" (Acts 2:41).

Tonight we consider 6 phases in counselling a child:

**(Psalms 99:9)** "... the LORD our God is holy."

3. Their understanding of \_\_\_\_\_,  
**(Romans 3:23)** "for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,"  
**(Romans 6:23)** "For the wages of sin is death, ..


**Every** person is a sinner. Romans 3:23 says, "All have sinned." Your sin deserves **punishment**. That punishment is separation from God forever. **Jesus**, God's Son, died on the cross to take your punishment and **forgive** your sins.

**(Romans 10:9)** "that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved."


**(1 Corinthians 15:3-4)** "For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that Christ died for our sins according to the

Believing in Jesus is . . .

1. believing that Jesus, the Son of God, is the **only** One Who can take away your sins;
2. believing that Jesus died and **rose again** to take the punishment for your sins;
3. trusting in Jesus as your **Savior**.
