3. The third day in the sequence is Nisan _____ or March _____, 30

AD: A _____,

(Mark 11:12) "Now the next day, when they had come out from Bethany, He was hungry."

(Mark 11:15) "So they came to Jerusalem. Then Jesus went into the temple and began to drive out those who bought and sold in the temple, and overturned the tables of the money changers and the seats of those who sold doves."

(Matthew 21:14) "Then the blind and the lame came to Him in the temple, and He healed them."

(Mark 11:19) "When evening had come, He went out of the city."

4. The fourth day in the sequence is Nisan _____ or March _____, 30

(Mark 11:28) "And they said to Him, "By what authority are You doing these things? And who gave You this authority to do these things?'"

(Matthew 21:41) "They said to Him, "He will destroy those wicked men miserably, and lease his vineyard to other vinedressers who will render to him the fruits in their seasons.""

(Luke 20:25) "And He said to them, "Render therefore to Caesar the things that are Caesar's, and to God the things that are God's.""

(Mark 12:25) ""For when they rise from the dead, they neither marry nor are given in marriage, but are like angels in heaven."
