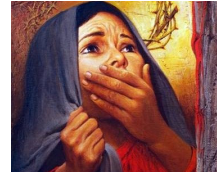


The Mercy of God in the Cross of Jesus Christ

(John 8:34) "... Most assuredly, I say to you, whoever commits sin is a slave of sin."

(1 Corinthians 6:20) "For you were bought at a price; .."

(Galatians 3:13) "Christ has redeemed us **from** the curse of the law, ...,"

(Titus 2:14) "who gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from every lawless deed and purify for Himself His own special people, zealous for good works."

(1 John 2:2) "And He Himself is the propitiation for our sins, and not for ours only but also for the whole world."
