A Heart to Worship

In Psalm 63 David models for us 3 requirements for a worshipping heart:

1. A heart that _____ God, verses 11, 9-10, 1-2

***(Psalms 42:1-3)** "As the deer pants for the water brooks, So pants my soul for You, O God. {2} My soul thirsts for God, for the living God. When shall I come and appear before God?"*

***{3}** My tears have been my food day and night,"*

***(Psalms 42:7)** "... All Your waves and billows have gone over me."*

2. A heart that _____ God, verses 3, 7-8

***(Psalm 63:3)** Your unfailing love is better to me than life itself; ...*

[paraphrase]

***(Ephesians 3:14)** "For this reason I bow my knees to the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ,"*

***(Ephesians 3:16-19)** "that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with might through His Spirit in the inner man, {17} that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; that you, being rooted and grounded in love, {18} may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the width and length and depth and height; {19} to know the love of Christ which passes knowledge; that you may be filled with all the fullness of God."*

3. A heart that _____ to Him in _____, verses 3-6, 8, 11

***(Psalm 63:3-5)**.. I will praise you. 4I will praise you as long as I live. I will lift up my hands in prayer to your name. 5 I will be content as if I had eaten the best foods. My lips will sing, and my mouth will praise you.*

***(Psalm 63:6)** I lie awake thinking of you, meditating on you through the night.*

***(Psalms 63:8)** My soul clings to you;*

***(Psalm 63:11)** But the king will rejoice in his God. All who make promises in his name will praise him, ... [collated paraphrases]*
