sorrow—about countless people today. They try one thing after another to quench the thirst of their souls. Many people even resort to an empty spirituality, which Campbell did so much to popularise. But as the prophet Jeremiah said, they've made for themselves "broken cisterns that can hold no water" (Jer. 2:13).

Whatever Campbell himself may have believed, "the Source that makes everything green" is Jesus Christ our blessed Saviour. He is the One who gives "living water," which becomes "a fountain of water springing up into everlasting life" (Jn. 4:10,14).

If you have responded to the gospel and personally received Jesus Christ as your Saviour from sin, you have that fountain springing up within your soul (Jn. 7:37-38). Now you can pray for the "baffled" people around you, and offer the "living water" to those who are thirsty and wandering in a parched, Christless wasteland. –VCG
