(Matthew 5:3-6) *"Blessed are the poor in spirit, For theirs is the kingdom of heaven. {4} Blessed are those who mourn, For they shall be comforted. {5} Blessed are the meek, For they shall inherit the earth. {6} Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, For they shall be filled."*

(Matthew 7:9-11) *"Or what man is there among you who, if his son asks for bread, will give him a stone? {10} Or if he asks for a fish, will he give him a serpent? {11} If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your*

Father who is in heaven give good things to those who ask Him!"

2. God's _____, verses 2-3,

(Revelation 15:3-4) *"... "Great and marvelous are Your works, Lord God Almighty! Just and true are Your ways, O King of the saints! {4} Who shall not fear You, O Lord, and glorify Your name? For You alone are holy. For all nations shall come and worship before You, For Your judgments have been manifested."*

(Revelation 16:5-6) *".. "You are righteous, O Lord, The One who is and who was and who is to be, Because You have judged these things. {6} For they have shed the blood of saints and prophets, And You have given them blood to drink. For it is their just due."*

(Revelation 19:1-4) *".. "Alleluia! Salvation and glory and honor and power belong to the Lord our God! {2} "For true and righteous are His judgments, because He has judged the great harlot who corrupted the earth with her fornication; and He has avenged on her the blood of His servants shed by her." {3} Again they said, "Alleluia!
