From Romans 7 we can make three statements about the Christian's relationship to the law:

1. The law _____ longer _____ the Christian, verses 6:2, 1-6

***(Romans 7:5)** "For when we were in the flesh, the motions of sins, which were by the law, did work in our members to bring forth fruit unto death." [KJV]*

2. The law _____ to _____ the Christian, verses 7, 12, 14, 16, 22, 25, 6:2,

***(Psalms 19:7-11)** "The law of the LORD is perfect, converting the soul; The testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple; {8} The statutes of the LORD are right, rejoicing the heart; The commandment of the LORD is pure, enlightening the eyes; ..{10} More to be desired are they than gold, Yea, than much fine gold; Sweeter also than honey and the honeycomb. {11} Moreover by them Your servant is warned, And in keeping them there is great reward."*



3. The law has no _____ for the Christian, verses 8-10, 21-23, 8:1

***(Zechariah 3:1)** "Then he showed me Joshua the high priest standing before the Angel of the LORD, and Satan standing at his right hand to oppose him."*

***(Luke 22:31)** "And the Lord said, "Simon, Simon! Indeed, Satan has asked for you, that he may sift you as wheat."*
