## Worship 11

1 Corinthians 14 gives 8 guidelines for the practice of tongues and thus 8 guidelines for our worship....

1. The priority of worship is love, verse 1
2. The test of worship is growth, verses 1-4, 10-11, 6, 12, 18-19, 26
3. The means of worship is the mind, verses 5, 7-11, 13-17, 28



**4. The giftedness for worship \_\_\_\_\_; it depends on God's \_\_\_\_\_, verses 20-22, 1:4-7**



**(Isaiah 28:11)** "For with stammering lips and another tongue He will speak to this people,"

**(Acts 11:17-18)** "If therefore God gave them the same gift as He gave us when we believed on the Lord Jesus Christ, who was I that I could withstand God?" {18} When they heard these things they became silent; and they glorified God, saying, "Then God has also granted to the Gentiles repentance to life."

**5. The elements of worship should be \_\_\_\_\_, verses 26-29**

**(Colossians 3:16)** "Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord."



**6. The form of worship should be \_\_\_\_\_, verses 29-35, 11:5, 40**

**(Genesis 3:16)** "... Your desire shall be for your husband, And he shall rule over you."

**(1 Timothy 2:11-12)** "Let a woman learn in silence with all submission. {12} And I do not permit a woman to teach or to have authority over a man, but to be in silence."



**7. The leaders in worship should be \_\_\_\_\_, verses 29, 32**



**(1 John 4:1)** "Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits, whether they are of God; because many false prophets have gone out into the world."

**(Acts 17:11)** "These were more fair-minded than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness, and searched the Scriptures daily to find out whether these things were so."



**8. The attitude for worship is \_\_\_\_\_, verses 36-38**

**(Psalms 51:17)** "The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit, A broken and a contrite heart; These, O God, You will not despise."
