

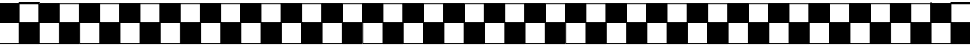
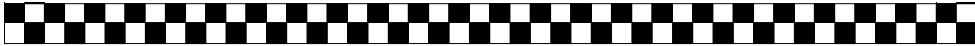
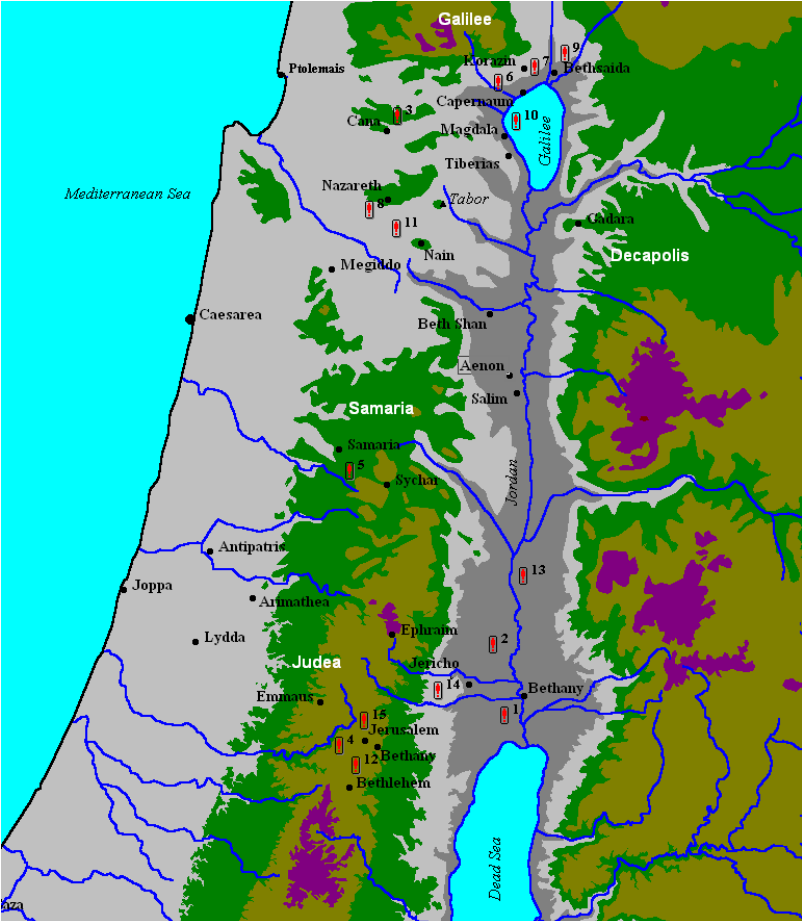
Peter

Meeting Christ

In the account of Peter's salvation in John 1:40f there are three spiritual lessons for us to take home and take to heart:

1. Be _____ (because those who are _____ will be _____), verses 29, 35-41

(Matthew 11:21) "Woe to you, Chorazin! Woe to you, Bethsaida! For if the mighty works which



were done in you had been done in Tyre and Sidon, they would have repented long ago in sackcloth and ashes."

(John 7:15) "And the Jews marveled, saying, "How does this Man know letters, having never studied?""

(Acts 4:13) "Now when they saw the boldness of Peter and John, and perceived that they were uneducated and untrained men, they marveled. And they realized that they had been with Jesus."

(Matthew 3:1-2) "In those days John the Baptist came preaching in the wilderness of Judea, {2} and saying, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand!"

(Mark 1:5) "Then all the land of Judea, and those from Jerusalem, went out to him and were all baptized by him in the Jordan River, confessing their sins."

(Matthew 3:5) "..., and all the region around the Jordan went out to him"

(Mark 1:9) "It came to pass in those days that Jesus came from Nazareth of Galilee, and was baptized by John in the Jordan."

(Luke 3:1-2) "Now in the fifteenth year of the reign of Tiberius Caesar, Pontius Pilate being governor of Judea, ..., {2}..., the word of God came to John the son of Zacharias in the wilderness."

(Luke 3:23) "Now Jesus Himself began His ministry at about thirty years of age, ..."

◆ DAY 3, verses 35-41

(Matthew 5:6) "Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, For they shall be filled."

(Matthew 7:7-8) ""Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. {8} "For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened."

(Philippians 3:10) "that I may know Him and the power of His resurrection, and the fellowship of His sufferings, being conformed to His death,"

(Ephesians 3:14-19) "For this reason I bow my knees to the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, {15} from whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named, {16} that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with might through His Spirit in the inner man, {17} that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; that you, being rooted and grounded in love, {18} may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the width and length and depth and height; {19} to know the love of Christ which passes knowledge; that you may be filled with all the fullness of God."

(John 4:13-14) "... "Whoever drinks of this water will thirst again, {14} "but whoever drinks of the water that I shall give him will never thirst. But the water that I shall give him will become in him a fountain of water springing up into everlasting life."

(John 6:35) "... and he who believes in Me shall never thirst."

(John 7:37-38) "..., "If anyone thirsts, let him come to Me and drink. {38} "He who believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart will flow rivers of living water.""

(Revelation 7:16-17) ""They shall neither hunger anymore nor thirst anymore; ...;" {17} ""for the Lamb who is in the midst of the throne will shepherd them and lead them to living fountains of



waters. And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes.""

(Revelation 21:6) "... I will give of the fountain of the water of life freely to him who thirsts."

(Revelation 22:17) "... And let him who thirsts come. Whoever desires, let him take the water of life freely."
