(Joshua 1:6-9) ""Be strong and of good courage, for to this people you shall divide as an inheritance the land ... {7} "Only be strong and very courageous, that you may observe to do according to all the law ...; do not turn from it ... that you may prosper wherever you go. {8} "This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success. {9} "Have I not commanded you? Be strong and of good courage; do not be afraid, nor be dismayed, for the LORD your God is with you wherever you go.""

(Matthew 26:50) "But Jesus said to him, "Friend, why have you come?" ..."

(Luke 22:48) ".. "Judas, are you betraying the Son of Man with a kiss?"

(John 18:4-9) "Jesus therefore, knowing all things that would come upon Him, went forward and said to them, "Whom are you seeking?"

{5} They answered Him, "Jesus of Nazareth." Jesus said to them, "I am He." And Judas, who betrayed Him, also stood with them. {6} Now when He said to them, "I am He," they drew back and fell to the ground. {7} Then He asked them again, "Whom are you seeking?" And they said, "Jesus of Nazareth." {8} Jesus answered, "I have told you that I am He. Therefore, if you seek Me, let these go their way," {9} that the saying might be fulfilled which He spoke, "Of those whom You gave Me I have lost none.""

(Luke 22:49) "When those around Him saw what was going to happen, they said to Him, "Lord, shall we strike with the sword?"
