In Acts 1-2 we see two aspects of Peter's Godly leadership:

- **Acts 1:** Peter leads by shepherding the sheep
  - **Acts 2:** Peter leads by seeking the sheep
- From Peter's seeking the sheep in Acts 2 we can state 3 imperatives for all Christian teaching and preaching:

(Exodus 3:2) "And the Angel of the LORD appeared to him in a flame of fire from the midst of a bush. ..."

(1 Peter 3:15-16) "But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts, and always be ready to give a defense to everyone who asks you a reason for the hope that is in you, with meekness and fear; {16} having a good conscience, that when they defame you as evildoers, those who revile your good conduct in Christ may be ashamed."

**2. The message must be \_\_\_\_\_, verses 16-35**

(Romans 11:26) "And so all Israel will be saved, ...;"

(Psalms 16:1-2) "Preserve me, O God, for in You I put my trust. {2} O my soul, you have said to the LORD, "You are my Lord, My goodness is nothing apart from You.""

(Psalms 16:8-11) "I have set the LORD always before me; Because He is at my right hand I shall not be moved. {9} Therefore my heart is glad, and my glory rejoices; My flesh also will rest in hope.

{10} For You will not leave my soul in Sheol, Nor will You allow Your Holy One to see corruption. {11} You will show me the path of life; In Your presence is fullness of joy; At Your right hand are pleasures forevermore."

(2 Timothy 4:2-3) "Preach the word! Be ready in season and out of season. Convince, rebuke, exhort, with all longsuffering and teaching. {3} For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine, but according to their own desires, because they have itching ears, they will heap up for themselves teachers;"
