Last Glimpses

We look at two last contrasting glimpses of Peter:

1. When Peter got it _____,

Galatians 1:11-18, 2:1-16

(Acts 11:29-30) "Then the disciples, each according to his ability, determined to send relief to the brethren dwelling in Judea. {30} This they also did, and sent it to the elders by the hands of Barnabas and Saul."

(Acts 15:39) "Then the contention became so sharp that they parted from one another. ...;"

(2 Timothy 4:11) "... Get Mark and bring him with you, for he is useful to me for ministry."

(Matthew 23:13) "'But woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you shut up the kingdom of heaven against men; for you neither go in yourselves, nor do you allow those who are entering to go in."

(Jude 1:3) "...contend earnestly for the faith which was once for all delivered to the saints."

(Jude 1:22-23) "And on some have compassion, making a distinction; {23} but others save with fear, pulling them out of the fire, hating even the garment defiled by the flesh."



2. When Peter got it _____, Acts 15:1-19

(Colossians 4:6) "Let your speech always be with grace, ..."

(Luke 5:37) "'And no one puts new wine into old wineskins; or else the new wine will burst the wineskins and be spilled, and the wineskins will be ruined."

(Genesis 17:11) "'and you shall be circumcised in the flesh of your foreskins, and it shall be a sign of the covenant between Me and you."

(Matthew 28:19) "'Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,"

(Matthew 9:37-38) "Then He said to His disciples, "The harvest truly is plentiful, but the laborers are few. {38} "Therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest.'"
