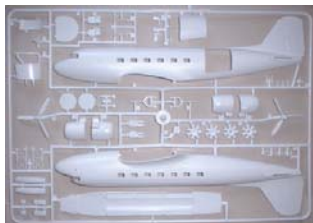

4. Kingdom priorities, verses 19-34 [last time]



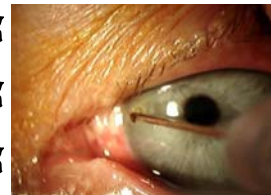
