
Matthew 12:9, 11

(Hebrews 1:3) "... upholding all things by the word of His power,"

(Genesis 2:2-3) "And on the seventh day God ended His work which He had done, and He rested on the seventh day from all His work which He had done. {3}

Then God blessed the seventh day and sanctified it, because in it He rested from all His work which God had created and made."

2. God _____ the _____,

(Luke 6:1-3) "Now it happened on the second Sabbath after the first that He went through the grainfields.

And His disciples plucked the heads of grain and ate them, rubbing them in their hands. {2} And some of the Pharisees said to them, "Why are you doing what is not lawful to do on the Sabbath?"

[3] But Jesus answering them said, "Have you not even read this, what David did when he was hungry, he and those who were with him:"

(Mark 2:26) ""how he went into the house of God in the days of Abiathar the high priest, and ate the showbread, which is not lawful to eat, except for the priests, and also gave some to those who were with him?""
