God Tests His Man II

Test #2, a near death experience, can be divided into 4 scenes (2 Kings 20):

1. ______, verses 1, 7

(2 Chronicles 32:24-25) "In those days Hezekiah was sick and near death, and he prayed to the LORD; and He spoke to him and gave him a sign. {25} But Hezekiah did not repay according to the favor shown him, for his heart was lifted up; therefore wrath was looming over him and over Judah and Jerusalem.

(2 Chronicles 32:25) "But Hezekiah's heart was proud and he did not respond to the kindness shown him; ..." [NIV]

(2 Chronicles 32:26) Then Hezekiah humbled himself for the pride of his heart, he and the inhabitants of Jerusalem, so that the wrath of the LORD did not come upon them in the days of Hezekiah."
(Daniel 4:30-32) "..., "Is not this great Babylon, that I have built ...



by my mighty power and for the honor of my majesty?" [31] While the word was still in the king's mouth, a voice fell from heaven: ".. the kingdom has departed from you! [32] .. and your dwelling shall be with the beasts of the field. They shall make you eat grass like oxen; .. until you know that the Most High rules in the kingdom of men, and gives it to whomever He chooses.""

(Daniel 4:37) "Now I, Nebuchadnezzar, praise and extol and honor the King of heaven, all of whose works are truth, and His ways justice. And those who walk in pride He is able to put down."

(Isaiah 38:10-14) "I said, "In the prime of my life I shall go to the gates of Sheol; I am deprived of the remainder of my years."
