Riding A Rollercoaster

If you love someone who struggles with a substance-abuse problem, you know that your emotions and his can be like riding a rollercoaster—up and down. Today he wants help; tomorrow he's drinking or is high on drugs again, or at the computer. Today she's being honest; tomorrow she's running from the truth.

The Holy Spirit helps us to love people like that, even in their sins and struggles. Here are a few principles we can put into practice:

- ◆ Treat the person with respect. Be gentle when trying to restore him (Galatians 6:1-2 Brethren, if a man is overtaken in any trespass, you who are spiritual restore such a one in a spirit of gentleness, considering yourself lest you also be tempted. 2 Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ.) But don't do for him what he should do for himself. Don't get in the way of the consequences that God can use to bring change.
- Remember that you do not have the power to change another person. Instead, ask God to help you become the person He wants you to be (Galatians 6:3 For if








