It is not our business to judge God's enemies. "Vengeance is Mine, I will repay,' says the Lord" (Romans 12:19). Our business is to tell the world, and even those who oppose us, about His offer of salvation.

Paul gave us these instructions: "If your enemy is hungry, feed him; if he is thirsty, give him a drink' Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good" (vv.20-21). We must overwhelm evil opponents with love if we can, bring them to Jesus if they will come, and leave judgment with God. —DHR


Overcome Evil With Good

As Jesus began to make His way to Jerusalem, He sent messengers ahead to prepare a Samaritan village along the way for His arrival. But the people there rejected Him.

When James and John heard about their refusal, they fumed, "Lord, do You want us to command fire to come down from heaven and consume them?" (Luke 9:54). ... But when they asked if they could call down fiery judgment on the Samaritans, Jesus rebuked them.





Stability

The chronologically associated passages in Luke 9 and Mark 10 lead us to see 4 life principles that will stabilise our lives lead us to see 4 life principles through good and bad times:
